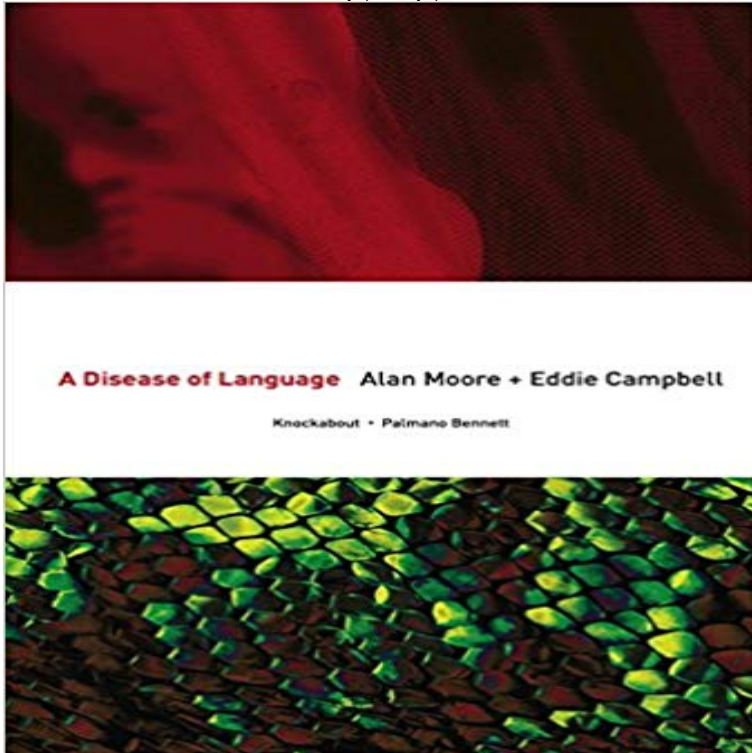


## A Disease of Language
