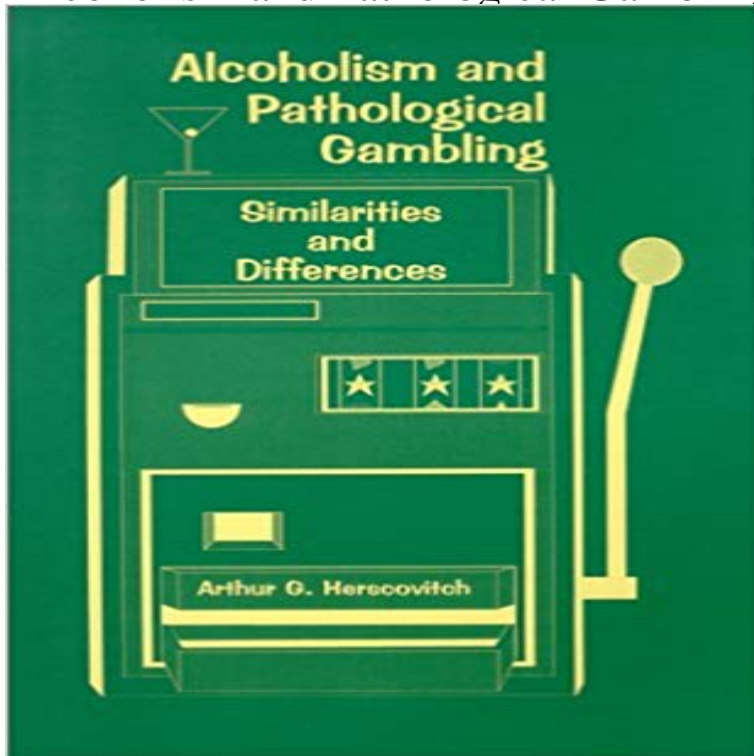


Alcoholism and Pathological Gambling: Similarities and Differences
