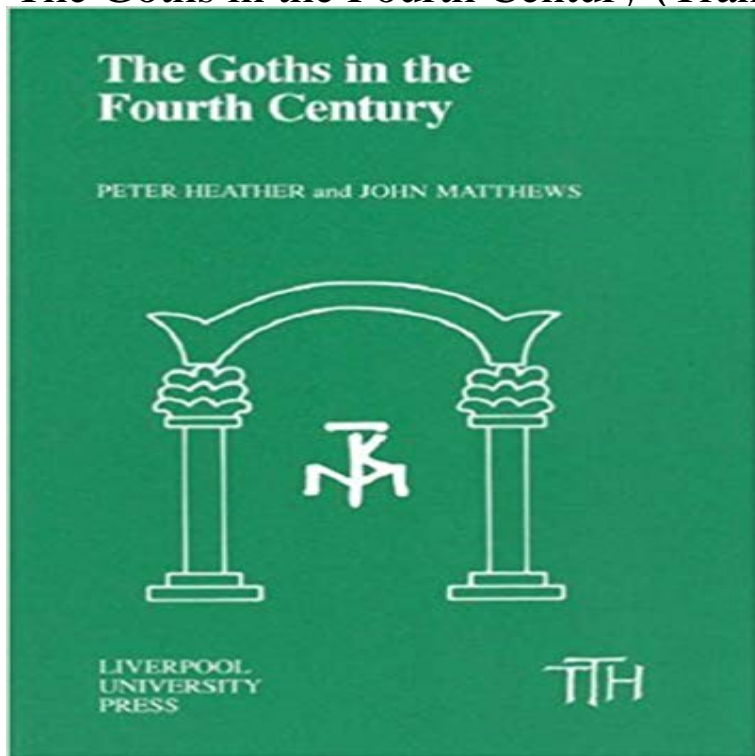


The Goths in the Fourth Century (Translated Texts for Historians LUP)
