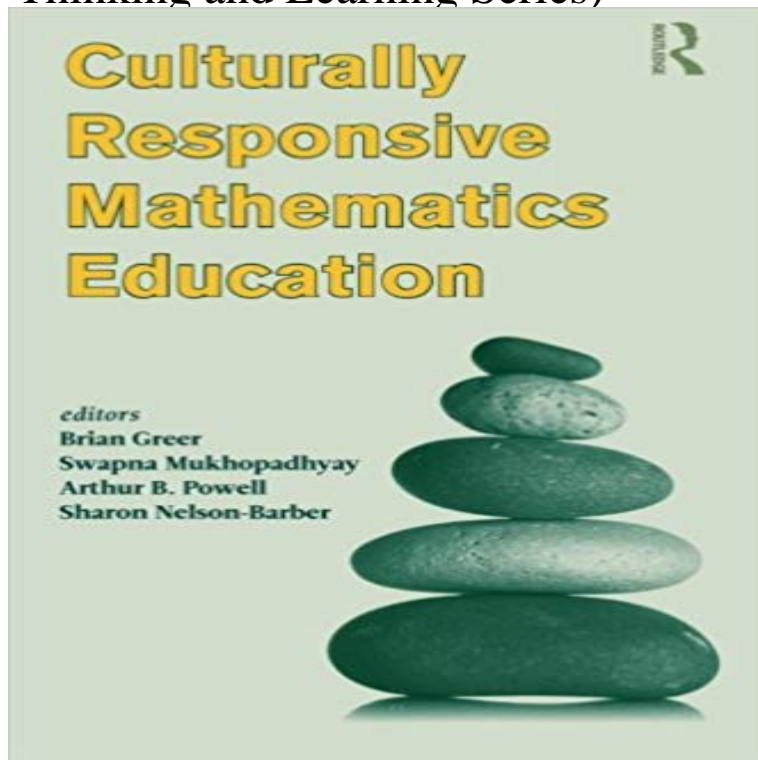


Culturally Responsive Mathematics Education (Studies in Mathematical Thinking and Learning Series)
