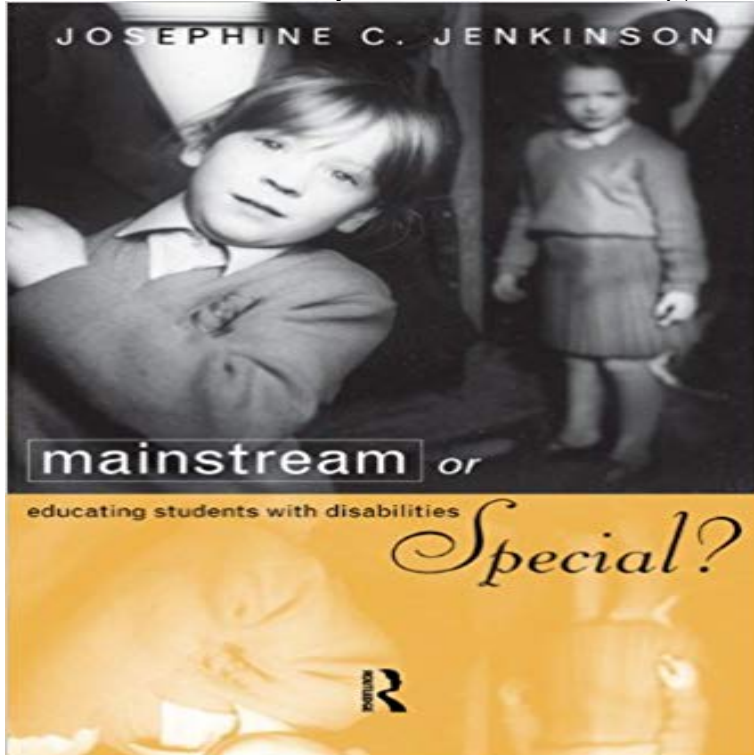


Mainstream or Special?: Educating Students with Disabilities
