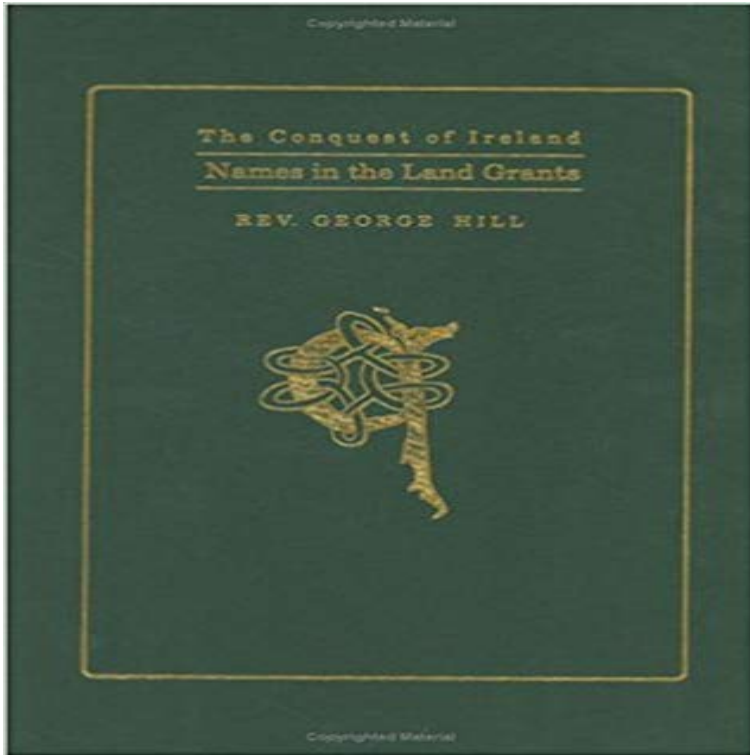


Names in the Irish Land Grants: An Historical & Genealogical Account of the Plantation in Ulster

The Land Grants in this work have been taken from the Patent Rolls of the reign of James I and from the printed Ulster Inquisitions. While the names and locations in the land grants will be of particular interest to family researchers, there is a wealth of information in the footnotes bringing history to life for all interested persons. The land grants are of differing lengths, and one very short example in Co. Tyrone follows: Grant to Neale OQuin, gent., Ballineloughy, one balliboe, containing 60 acres. Rent, 13 s. From the works of George Hill on the 17th century settlement of Ulster (1609+), the text includes footnotes with enlightening 19th century commentary.
