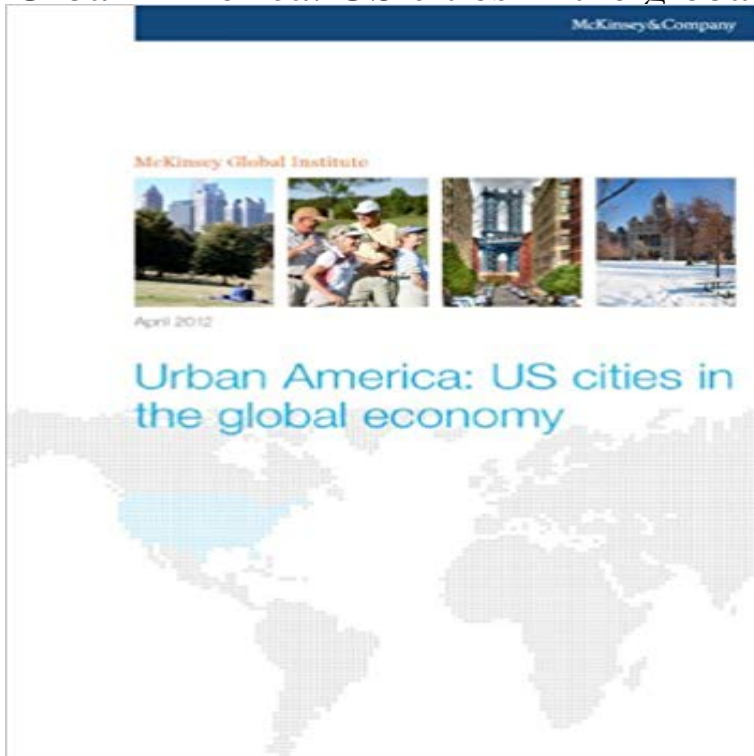


Urban America: US cities in the global economy
