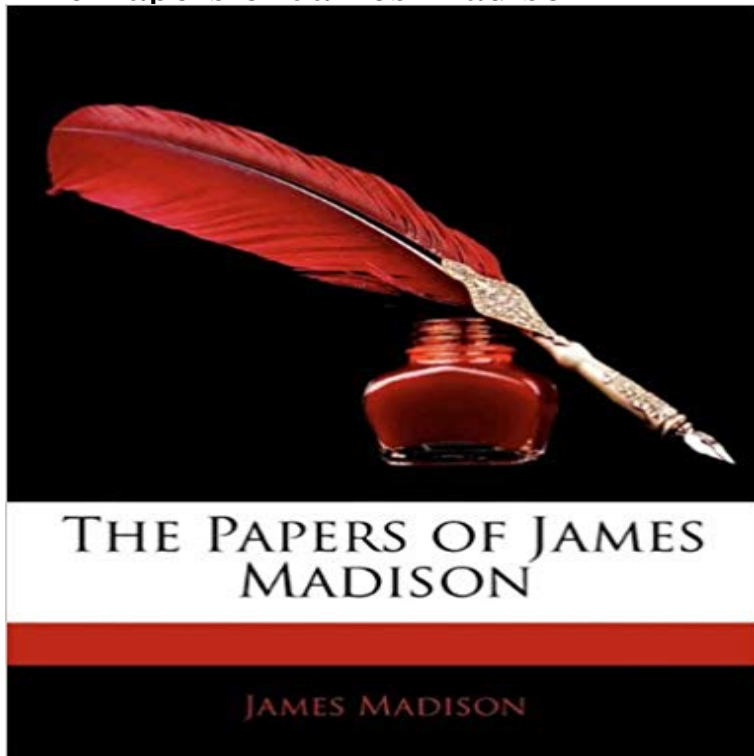


The Papers of James Madison
